To enhance accessibility and educational support, Mitra Jyothi produces high-quality Braille books, facilitating inclusive learning, promoting literacy, and fostering independence among individuals with visual impairments. Mitra Jyothi's Braille Transcription Centre has undertaken a significant project of printing textbooks in Braille for students from grade 1 to 12 (Karnataka State syllabus) for both Kannada and English medium, across 40 schools/institutions for the blind in Karnataka every year. We produce 1,00,000 pages of Braille every month.
