For over two decades, IDRF has played a crucial role in improving healthcare access in remote hilly villages by supporting **Vivekananda Kendra Arun Jyoti's Mobile Medical Clinics**. These clinics offer free medical camps, reaching approximately **43 villages and serving over 50,000 people** annually, ensuring that essential healthcare reaches those who need it most.

Under the *Mission Shakti* project, the medical team at Arun Jyoti has made remarkable strides in addressing anemia among women. Through regular testing, nutritional supplements, and dedicated counseling, **3,650 women have become anemia-free over the past three years**. This initiative stands as a testament to the sustained medical support and community-driven healthcare efforts supported by IDRF.





On Mother's Day, **Aabha Sagare**, a dedicated high school student from Maryland, took a meaningful step towards addressing anemia in women living in the remote hilly villages of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam. Abha organized a fundraiser by collaborating with Shonali Nazare, a long-time supporter of IDRF, to host a craft workshop on Mother's Day. The event attracted 15 participants, each contributing to the cause through their creative engagement and generosity.

The proceeds from the workshop were donated to IDRF's partner, Vivekananda Kendra Arun Jyoti, which leads Mission Shakti: an initiative to detect and eradicate anemia among women in remote villages of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam. Through these efforts, Aabha not only raised vital funds but also spread awareness about the critical health challenges faced by women in underserved communities.





BRIDGING THE EDUCATIONAL GAP Strengthening STEM Learning In Underserved Communities in Tamil Nadu

IDRF has played a pivotal role in establishing **STEM Tinker Labs** at the **Swami Vivekananda Rural Development Society Training Center** in Ulundai, fostering curiosity and innovation among young learners. Every Sunday morning, **80 middle school students from three villages** engage in hands-on computer and science-related activities, expanding their knowledge and skills in technology and scientific research.

This initiative has been made possible through the generous support of IDRF donor Gayathri Seenumani, whose contributions have helped sustain the program. Now in its second successful year, the project continues to inspire and empower students, providing them with invaluable learning opportunities that pave the way for a brighter future.









BREAKING TABOOS, BUILDING CONFIDENCE Transforming Menstrual Health For Rural Schoolgirls in Kerala & West Bengal

IDRF and **Auroville Foundation**, **USA**, have made a profound impact on the lives of **1,515 schoolgirls** by providing essential **menstrual education and sustainable cloth-pad kits**.
