



EMPOWERING WOMEN, REVIVING CRAFT: A Pathway to Economic Independence

In partnership with **Disease Eradication through Education & Prevention (DEEP)**, IDRF is unlocking new livelihood opportunities for women from the most marginalized communities in Hyderabad, Telangana. Through **bangle-making training**, widows and single mothers are gaining the skills and confidence to build sustainable incomes and a brighter future for their families.

This initiative is more than vocational training; it's a pathway to economic independence. These women are now selling their handcrafted bangles to four shops in the Charminar area, with many exploring entrepreneurship, artisan cooperatives, and local market participation. The vibrant artistry of Hyderabadi bangles, known for their intricate designs, is being preserved and revitalized through the hands of these resilient women.

To date, **105 women have completed the training**. IDRF is now extending this opportunity to 140 more women across four upcoming batches—ensuring that tradition thrives, and transformation continues.



EMPOWERING WOMEN THROUGH LIVELIHOODS: A New Pilot with Samerth Charitable Trust

IDRF has launched a transformative initiative to extend microloans to 115 women living below the poverty line in Ahmedabad and Kutch districts, Gujarat. This project is designed to provide sustainable livelihood opportunities by supporting farming-related efforts, such as land leveling and irrigation and local shops. Microloans also help fund the purchase of cattle and sewing machines, equipping women with tools to build income and independence.

Together, we're investing in women's economic agency and community-driven change—one seed, one shop, one story at a time.



Small Loan, Big Vision: A Case Study in Entrepreneurial Growth

Shaheen, 38, runs a thriving beauty accessories business from her home in Fatehwadi. With a sharp understanding of local demand, she and her husband launched the venture using their savings and determination.

As her customer base expanded, so did her aspirations. To meet growing demand and diversify her offerings, Shaheen approached Samerth Charitable Trust for support. An IDRF-enabled microloan of \$60 marked quite a turning point—enabling her to scale thoughtfully and sustainably. Her disciplined management and clear vision soon earned her a second round of support: \$240 to elevate her enterprise even further.

Shaheen's journey is more than a business success—it's a powerful reminder of what happens when women are trusted with resources and room to grow. She's not just growing a business—she's shaping a future rooted in resilience and purpose.
